MAINE WATER UTILITIES ASSOCIATION MADELEINE A. STORER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Purpose:

To encourage and promote the pursuit of a career in Maine's water and wastewater profession

Closing date:

November 30th, annually

Amount and Type of Award:

\$1,000 scholarship(s) will be awarded each year, the number to be determined as funding allows.

Eligibility Requirements:

High School graduate and intern at a water or water and wastewater facility and enrollment in an accredited secondary educational institution

Application requirements:

- Academic transcript
- Some evidence of commitment to community
- Completed application including a brief (no more than 300 words) essay on who you are and why you should be awarded this scholarship

Selection Criteria:

- Work history with a water or water and wastewater utility
- Acceptable level of academic achievement
- Expressed interest in pursuing a career in the water or wastewater field

Selection Process:

The recipient will be selected by a three member sub-committee of the MWUA Public Awareness Committee. Prior recipients may apply again, but will be limited to no more than two awards of the Madeleine A. Storer Memorial scholarship to any one individual.

Terms of Payment:

This scholarship will be payable after successful completion of the first semester at a post-secondary institution of learning. This is a one-time payment and is non-renewable.
